R-09-1 - A Resolution of the Town Council of Chesapeake Beach, Maryland, expressing the Mayor and Council's appreciation and thanks to the Calvert County Board of Elections for their assistance during the November 2008 Municipal Election.

3/19/09

R-09-2 - A Resolution of the Town Council of Chesapeake Beach, Maryland, authorizing the Town to continue its participation in the Baltimore/Washington Corridor Chamber of Commerce Energy Purchasing Cooperative, to participate in the bidding for electricity service through said cooperative, and to authorize the Mayor to accept bids on behalf of the Town, select a bidder, and execute a contract on behalf of the Town with said bidder.

O-09-1 - An Ordinance of the Town Council of Chesapeake Beach, Maryland, amending Section 5-201(G) of Chapter 50, Zoning Code, of the Town Code of Chesapeake Beach, to remove the prohibition against locating residential off street parking within the front setback area between the principal structure and the street. **THIS ORDINANCE DID NOT PASS DUE TO A LACK OF A MAJORITY VOTE.**

O-09-2 - An Ordinance of the Town Council of Chesapeake Beach, Maryland, Adopting the Annual Budget for the Town of Chesapeake Beach for the fiscal year July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010, to set property taxes, to set operating property taxes, to set the compensation of all Town officers and employees, and to ratify all technical deviations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, as amended.

R-09-4 - A Resolution of the Town Council of Chesapeake Beach for the purpose of making a Declaration of Official Intent pursuant to U.S. Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2 regarding Chesapeake Beach's intention to reimburse prior expenditures made in connection with the acquisition, construction, improvement, installation and equipping of a project identified as the D Street sewer improvements, together with related costs and financing costs, from the proceeds of one or more obligations to be issued by the Town.
